Iowa Christmas Bird Count, 2024-2025

Reports were submitted for fifty-five counts this season. Humboldt County returned after a one-year absence; Shelby County was a new addition. While Worth County reported their count last season, the CBC held in 2024–2025 was never compiled or reported.

According to the State Climatologist of Iowa, December's statewide average temperature was 28.2°F or 3.2 degrees above normal, while precipitation averaged 1.24 inches or 0.13 inch below normal. Most of the precipitation that fell during the month was rain as below average snowfall was reported statewide (IDLS 2024). Seven counts reported highs of 50°F or more, and all but one of those counts occurred on the 28th. Only five counts reported single digit lows. The lowest temperatures were 3°F on the 21st at Mason City and 5°F on 4 January at SE Clayton County. Just eight counts reported any snow, the heaviest being 4 inches at Yellow River Forest on the 19th.

The species count was 139. This number is four less than our tenyear average and ties for the lowest total during that stretch. The total bird count (879,959), however, was quite high. Davenport and Saylorville had the high counts with 94 species. Other high counts: Muscatine (92), Keokuk (88), Lamoni (86). DeSoto NWR (79) led the Missouri counts; NW Clayton County (62) led the northern counts. The average count this season had 15 field observers, 7 field parties, and 62 species.

REGULAR SPECIES

Seventeen regular species were found in record numbers. Frugivores, sparrows and icterids had excellent counts. Gallinaceous birds, raptors, owls, and woodpeckers were also in good numbers. Waterfowl numbers were relatively reduced this season with a few notable exceptions, as were gulls. Frequently reported species are recorded in Table 3; species found on three or fewer counts are recorded in Table 1.

Canada Geese (142,600) approached average numbers, while Cackling Geese (756) had their lowest count in ten years. Greater White-fronted Geese (2,204) were present in modest numbers across the state; Snow Geese (910) neared ten-year lows. But Ross's Geese (20) had their best count in decades.

Trumpeter Swans (5,007) comprised their second-highest count. Tundra Swans (2,100) were in average numbers but reported on 8 counts away from the Mississippi River. Cedar Falls-Waterloo had ten, and Des Moines reported seven. Princeton was the best location for both species of swans. Seven hundred Trumpeters at Amana were notable.

Mallards (71,460) were in large numbers, twice as many found last season. American Black Ducks (24) increased by half over last year but still below their average. Wood Ducks (21) had an average count; American Wigeon (41), Northern Pintail (102), Green-winged Teal (553) were all below average. Gadwall (278) were in relatively lower numbers, and Northern Shoveler (12) were scarce.

Canvasbacks (21,824) were a third below their average; the majority were at Keokuk and Clinton. Common Goldeneyes (23,749) established a new high; Redheads (73), Ring-necked Ducks (431), Lesser Scaup (1,851) Bufflehead (138), and Ruddy Ducks (490) all had just modest showings. Greater Scaup (405) were the only divers to be at their average count numbers. In contrast, the mergansers all counted well. Hooded Mergansers (605) had a record count for the second straight year; the largest numbers were at Clinton. Common Mergansers (21,062) had their second highest count. Red-breasted Mergansers (43) tied their best count in over twenty years. Long-tailed Ducks (7) were on five counts.

Pied-billed Grebes (2) were only at Omaha and Spirit Lake; American Coots (258) were only in fair numbers. Double-crested Cormorants (94) and American White Pelicans (1,828) were in record numbers, primarily at Keokuk, Burlington, Davenport, and Red Rock. Great Blue Herons (65) were half their average. Belted Kingfishers (146) were in good numbers. Sandhill Cranes (154) were found in modest numbers on four counts, primarily at Clinton. Wilson's Snipes (29) had their best count in nearly fifteen years; Killdeer (32) also had a good count.

Ring-billed Gulls (27,177) and Herring Gulls (1,637) were in relatively modest numbers. Iceland Gulls (9) were on four counts including four at Red Rock. Lesser Black-backed Gulls (6) were at Davenport, Keokuk, and Saylorville.

Northern Bobwhites (80) were average on eleven counts. Twenty-two bobwhite at Dallas County was notable. Wild Turkeys (2,121) and Ringnecked Pheasants (905) were both somewhat shy of their averages. Gray Partridges (18) were on three counts. Rock Pigeons (11,125) and Eurasian Collared-Doves (975) were above their averages. Mourning Doves (3,034) were nearly 400 birds below average numbers.

Bald Eagles (5,355) counted extremely well, their second highest ever. They were on every count, and Red Rock had nearly six hundred. Golden Eagles (6) were on five northeasterly counts; Northern Harriers (249) hit a new high. Cooper's Hawks (119) hit their average; Sharp-shinned Hawks (73) had their best year in eight. Red-shouldered Hawks (53) were just one shy of last year's record high; Lamoni and Ringgold County combined for 19 birds. Red-tailed Hawks (1,452) had one of their lowest counts of the past 25 years; Rough-legged Hawks (185) were somewhat off their average. American Kestrels (701) were plentiful; Merlins (33) approached record numbers. Peregrine Falcons (5) were on four counts; again, Des Moines had the only Peregrine away from the Mississippi.

Eastern Screech-Owls (126) were nearly average in number; Great Horned Owls were (260) spot-on average. Barred Owls (357) weren't far off last year's record high; Long-eared Owls (27) had only a modest count. Short-eared Owls (30) and Saw-whet Owls (26) had good counts, nearly identical to last season.

Red-headed Woodpeckers (644) had an above average count but well-off last year's record of 1,051; only five counts didn't report one. Red-headed Woodpeckers were more prevalent nearer the Mississippi, so thirty-eight at Boone County was notable. Red-bellied Woodpeckers (2,561) and Downy Woodpeckers (2,815) had average counts. Hairy Woodpeckers (943) had their third highest count. Yellow-bellied Sapsuckers (95) had their second highest count; Green Island, Davenport, and Andalusia each had a dozen. Northern Flickers (1,684) also had their second highest count; Pileated Woodpeckers (248) bettered last year's record by six.

Northern Shrikes (39) were about average; Loggerhead Shrikes (5) were at DeSoto NWR, Lamoni, and Ringgold County. Blue Jays (5,753) counted well, but American Crows (54,417) had their lowest count in seven years.

Black-capped Chickadees (5,020) and Tufted Titmice (683) were somewhat off their average. White-breasted Nuthatch (3,310) numbers have been remarkably consistent for many years. Red-breasted Nuthatches (33) tied their lowest count in twenty-two years. Brown Creepers (543) bettered a 35-year-old record high. Winter Wrens (93) also set a new high. Carolina Wrens (195) were in good numbers. Golden-crowned Kinglets (272) bettered a 24-year-old record. Ruby-crowned Kinglets (10) were reported on nine counts; Saylorville and Lamoni had the only Ruby-crowned Kinglets away from the Mississippi.

Eastern Bluebirds (1,782) hit a new high for the second straight year; American Robins (9,053) were quite plentiful. Hermit Thrushes (83) had a very good count. Northern Mockingbirds (9) were on three southern counts with six at Ringgold County. Brown Thrashers were on five counts, including one in SE Clayton County. Gray Catbirds (4) were on three counts with two at Cedar Falls-Waterloo. Cedar Waxwings (3,524) had an average showing. Yellow-rumped Warblers (191) had a good count; Green Island had an amazing 44 birds. European Starlings (123,885) are doing exceedingly well; Des Moines reported 36,000 for the second straight year.

Eastern Towhees (11) included six at Lost Nation. Five counts reported Spotted Towhees (21), a new high with seven at DeSoto NWR and ten at Omaha. American Tree Sparrows (15,292) were in above average numbers. Dark-eyed Juncos (21,795) were typical. It was a good year for Fox Sparrows (63); Saylorville had thirteen. White-throated Sparrows (1,892) and White-crowned Sparrows (314) were in record numbers; Harris's Sparrows (306) have counted really well over the last three years. Song Sparrows (751) also counted well; Swamp Sparrows (104) had their lowest count in 14 years. Lincoln's Sparrows (13) had one of their best counts; five were at Ringgold County.

Unprecedented numbers of Savannah Sparrows (168) were reported. Their previously best season, 1986, produced 36 birds, and only two other years had ten or more reported. Lamoni led the way with 89, Muscatine had 43, and Ringgold County added 22. Field Sparrows (22) were also in exceptional numbers. Eleven were at Louisa Y, and five were at Green Island.

Horned Larks (1,392) were about a third of their average; Lapland Longspurs (1,128) were nearly as scarce. Snow Buntings (117) were difficult to find, but SE Webster County had fifty. Meadowlarks (1,334) set a new high; Each year more counts report meadowlarks to a particular species. The Western Meadowlark is the default winter species for most of Iowa, and many counts chose to report meadowlarks as such. Only four counts reported both meadowlark species. Interestingly, Lamoni reported nearly all Eastern Meadowlarks, while nearby Ringgold County to the northwest, reported nearly all Western Meadowlarks. Red-winged Blackbirds (173,624) and Common Grackles (40,327) were again in exceptional numbers and widespread. Brown-headed Cowbirds (8,359) were in record numbers. Rusty Blackbirds (182) were about average, but Dallas County had sixty. Brewer's Blackbirds (17) were average and on four counts with thirteen birds at Omaha.

House Sparrows (22,959) and Eurasian Tree Sparrows (2,972) were in average numbers. They continued their expansion and were reported northwest to Mason City and west to Ringgold County. House Finches (3,641) and Purple Finches (837) had excellent counts; Red Crossbills (19) were reported from three northeastern counts. Common Redpolls (9) were at Yellow River and Green Island. American Goldfinches (3,162) were below their average, but Pine Siskins (35) were scarce. Northern Cardinals (5,469) were on every count but in relatively modest numbers.

NOTABLE MISSES

Mute Swan (reported on 8 of the last 10 counts), Townsend's Solitaire (7 of last 10), White-winged Scoter, Common Loon (6 of last 10), Glaucous Gull (5 of last 10).

UNCOMMON SPECIES

There was a new bird to the count this season. A Golden-crowned Sparrow was a count week bird at Ringgold County, although the bird was within the northern part of the count circle that overlaps Union County to the north. The bird was well documented and accepted by the IOU Records Committee (see article in this issue).

Another terrific bird was a Barrow's Goldeneye at Keokuk, the first on the count in over twenty years. A Ruffed Grouse was at SE Clayton County; two Horned Grebes were at Davenport. A whopping 24 Turkey Vultures were at Keokuk, some within Missouri and the others in Illinois. Iowa City also had a Turkey Vulture. Mason City had the only American

Goshawk. Perhaps second only to the Golden-crowned Sparrow sighting this season was observation of an American Barn Owl at Ringgold County. A count week Snowy Owl was at Iowa City; a count week Prairie Falcon was also at Ringgold County. A Marsh Wren was at Princeton; Jamaica had a single Great-tailed Grackle. Ringgold County also saw an Indigo Bunting, but unfortunately, no Greater Prairie Chickens were seen this season.

Lastly, Omaha reported an Osprey to National Audubon Society, but no documentation was forwarded to the IOU, so it was not included in their totals here.
