### **Chuck-will's-widows near Waubonsie S.P.**

**Directions:** A traditional spot for CWWi. At the northwest edge of Waubonsie S.P. in southwest Fremont Co. is the intersection of Hwy. 2 and L-44/Bluff Rd. Proceed north on L-44 slightly over one mile to 270th Ave. on your right. Take 270th, and after about 1/4 mile it bends strongly left. You will see a conspicuous, large new house up on a hillside overlooking a sloping field alongside the road. Park along here at dusk and listen.

**Directions:** take 200th Street west from I-29 to 175th Avenue. Turn south on 175th Ave. to 210th Street and turn west. Take 210th St. west until you reach the levee. Drive over the levee and there is a parking area (in poor condition).

**Directions:** In the northwest corner of Fremont Co., take the Tabor exit (J-10) going east off of I-29. Almost immediately turn south on Western Ave., just under three miles to 135th St. going east. 135th runs close along the south shore of Forney Lake, and the water is easily scoped. If you continue east, the first crossroad at the end of the lake is L-44/Bluff Rd. Turning north, there are two parking areas along L-44 at the east end of the wetland.

The Sheldon Basin area is about one mile south on 220th, near 210th St. To avoid the dirt road, off I-29 instead go south through Percival two miles, along 195th Ave., to 220th St. Go east on 220th St. a little more than two miles to 220th Ave., and then north one mile.
